From November 27-30, there will be no school due to Tazaungdaing festival.

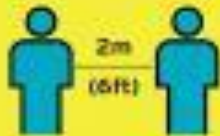

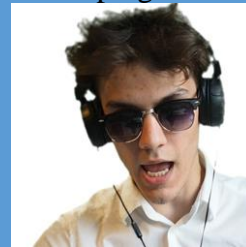

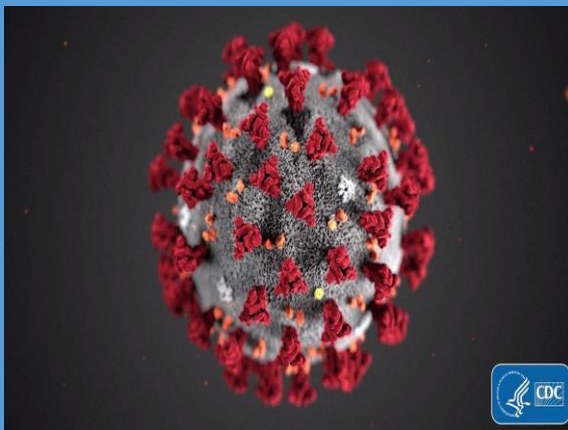
2020

Humans and the Entire Existence of the universe

We all are living on a planet called the Earth. The Earth is the only planet in the solar system that can support life. This is because it has all the physical conditions for the living things to survive. There are three layers which support life on Earth. There is an atmosphere, hydrosphere and the geosphere. The planet's atmosphere provides air to breath and there's liquid water in the planet's hydrosphere. In addition, sunlight provides energy and there's a moderate temperature. There are many planets in the universe, not just the Earth. The solar system is made up of the sun and the celestial bodies that orbits it. Eight planets orbit the Sun. Satellites orbit some of the planets. The Earth has one satellite, the moon but some planets have more than one satellite.

The Moon is about 4 times smaller than the Earth. It's the earth's only natural satellite. The moon orbits the earth as the Earth orbits the sun. It takes the moon about 28 days to complete one orbit of the Earth and the same time to complete one rotation. This is why we always see the same side of the Moon from the Earth. The moon like the Earth doesn't produce its own light. It receives light from the sun. We can see the moon because it reflects some light to the Earth. Although half of the moon is always illuminated, we can only see the illuminated part facing the earth. This is why, when we look at the moon on different nights doing the lunar month, its shape changes. These different shapes are called phases of the Moon.

Just two or three days ago, NASA found the traces of Water in the Sunlit Parts of the Moon for the first time. The discovery was made by using Sofia, the world's largest flying observatory. The water was detected in the clavius crater. Large crater in the moon's southern hemisphere visible from the Earth. They said the water may be delivered by tiny meteorite impacts or formed by the interaction of energetic particles ejected from the sun. finding further the case that the water is not limited in the moon's, shadowed region and maybe distributed across the lunar surface. They also said learning more about the water in the moon may support long term exploration under the Artemis Program. I think having water on the moon will help us in many different ways. What do you think?
